Curriculum

HEALTH AND EDUCATION: makes humanities and social sciences dialogue with health sciences, with a generative approach that considers biomedical, socio-economic and cultural aspects. The main objective is to train qualified researchers who can "humanize" health care and develop a detailed understanding of population health needs, considering changes within the NHS. PhDs will gain skills to promote the effectiveness and sustainability of the NHS through research, training, communication and outreach. The curriculum is characterized by the integration of multidisciplinary research and practical application, offering the skills needed to analyze health experiences and intervene at various levels: ethical and social issues in medicine and health sciences, physician-patient relationships, the role of technology, the distribution of health resources, the impact of health policies on society, and issues related to inclusion, access to care, and diversity. Doctoral students will have the ability to develop/implement health education programs locally and globally to promote the development of technical, professional, digital, and managerial skills of health personnel. The distinctiveness of the curriculum lies in its hermeneutic perspective of pedagogical knowledge, promoting the development of a broad viewpoint on the relationship between health and well-being, in its different declinations of "well-being" and "welfare".

WELFARE AND LIFESTYLE: with reference to the development of generative approaches based on the epistemological and methodological value of Innovation Studies, this curriculum focuses on the analysis of welfare systems understood as capacitating instruments of well-being. Adopting interdisciplinary methods, it proposes the development of skills in the elaboration, promotion and introduction of tools focused on sharing, participation and empowerment both with respect to local networks and communities of practice and with reference to experiences of multicultural inclusion and sharing. In this perspective, it organizes the contents in order to define processes and methods for the identification, introduction and maintenance of widespread welfare with social consideration, i.e., directed toward the achievement of economic and social development that is also sustainable from the environmental point of view and with regard to respect for and enhancement of cultural affiliations, identities and characterizations. In particular, with the aim of establishing a relationship between issues of social citizenship and issues related to the management of public space, this curriculum aims to assign welfare a specific dimension and meanings such that actions, processes, and tools can provide governance directions based on innovative systems of collective intelligence.
