Curriculum

HEALTH AND EDUCATION: it connects the human and social sciences with those of health by adopting a generative approach capable of connecting biomedical, socio-economic and cultural aspects. Founded on a common hermeneutic perspective between sociology, economics and pedagogy (Innovation Studies), this curriculum focuses on the relationship between health and well-being, with a specific spotlight on the different declinations of welfare and well-being in a comparative key too.

The main objective is to train researchers in "humanising" healthcare, i.e. able in developing a detailed understanding of the health needs of the population in consideration of changes within the NHS.

PhD students will acquire a multidisciplinary preparation focused on the combination/integration of themes and questions such as ethical and social questions in the field of medicine and health sciences, the relationships between doctors and patients, the role of technology, the distribution of health resources, the impact of health policies on society, issues related to inclusion, access to care and diversity.

PhDs will involve in training activities and practical experiences, planned for the acquiring of technical-professional skills as well as managerial ones.

	<p>WELFARE AND LIFESTYLE: in reference to the development of generative approaches based on the epistemological and methodological value of Innovation Studies, this curriculum is focused on the analysis of welfare systems understood as enabling tools for well-being. By adopting interdisciplinary methods, the purpose is the improvement of public involvement activities and community empowerment programs. So, its focus concerns the management of networks and communities of practices building, addressed to economic and social sustainability goals.</p> <p>According with innovative collective intelligence systems and with the intention of experimenting well-being models that we call "social equivalent", PhD students will acquire a multidisciplinary preparation, referred both the promotion of specific dimensions of welfare and the development of behavior oriented to citizenship, public space, social rights and collective actions.</p> <p>PhD student training activities will aim the development of governance strategies and tools, both useful for the acquiring of technical-professional skills as well as managerial ones.</p>
